CHILI COOKOFF

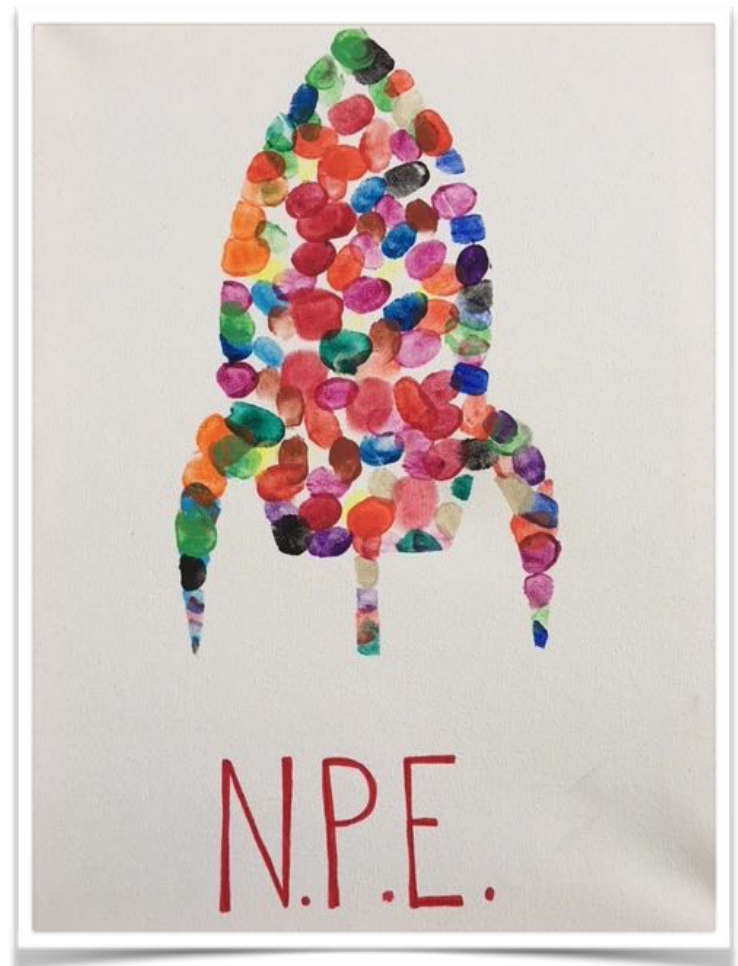
